

Resources for students with children:

Center for Child Care & Family Resources: Located in the Union, room 408. Help finding a daycare and help with locating campus resources for parents. www.childcare.utah.edu

Marriott Library Family Reading Room (Level 3 of library): computers, age-appropriate books, toys, etc. for children under 12. May be used by all student parents at the U of U. There is also a lactation room and 2 family study rooms.
